Complete panel submissions (four presenters) may be submitted individually, but should also be sent as a single email by the panel chair, giving complete contact information for all presenters, proposals and titles for all submissions, as well as a panel title. Presentations are allowed approximately 15 minutes per panelist with additional time for Q&A.
